From Peter's confession: "You are the Messiah" Jesus is spoken of as the Suffering Servant of Isaiah who fulfils all that was announced on his way of the cross.

This is a perspective to be taken into account: life in faith and works, including the yoke of the cross. Three times Jesus announced his passion and death for us. Jesus knew well that he was heading from the cradle to the cross and resurrection, but the disciples could not understand that this was the end of a powerful and merciful Messiah in whom they believed.

Hence Peter began to rebuke him and Jesus had to rebuke him because his attitude was satanic and unfaithful. "Get out of my sight, Satan, you think like men. not like God!

The theologian Julio Lois when defining what authentic Christian spirituality consists of points out three features: to know reality, to bear reality and to change reality. God calls us to commit ourselves, from our faith, and with our works to bring down from the cross the crucified of this world. For faith without works is dead by itself. Both the letter of James and today's gospel account warn us against the temptation of an intimate spirituality, a mere intellectual adherence to dogmas, or a privatisation of faith. No, faith is a personal encounter with Jesus, lived in community, which leads us to live in a filial relationship with the God of the Kingdom and with people, our brothers and sisters. God becomes present in our sufferings. Do you carry your cross? How do you combine faith and works in your life? To say: I believe in God and not live according to God's plan is a mockery of the Lord and a scandal before men. **Fr Marek Dutkiewicz PP**

ENTRANCE ANTIPHON Cf Sirach 36:18

Give peace, O Lord, to those who wait for you, that your prophets be found true. Hear the prayers of your servant, and of your people Israel.

FIRST READING Isaiah 50:5-9

A reading from the prophet Isaiah

I gave my body to those who struck me. The Lord has opened my ear. For my part, I made no resistance, neither did I turn away. I offered my back to those who struck me, my cheeks to those who tore at my beard; I did not cover my face against insult and spittle. The Lord comes to my help, so that I am untouched by the insults. So, too, I set my face like flint; I know I shall not be shamed. My vindicator is here at hand. Does anyone start proceedings against me? Then let us go to court together. Who thinks he has a case against me? Let him approach me. The Lord is coming to my help, who dare condemn me? The Word of the Lord. **The Word of the Lord.**

RESPONSORIAL PSALM Ps 114:1-6. 8-9. R. v.9

(R.) I will walk in the presence of the Lord, in the land of the living.

- 1. I love the Lord for he has heard the cry of my appeal; for he turned his ear to me in the day when I called him. (R.)
- 2. They surrounded me, the snares of death, with anguish of the tomb; they caught me, sorrow and distress.
- I called on the Lord's name. O Lord my God, deliver me! (R.)

SECOND READING James 2:14-18

A reading from the letter of St James

Take the case, my brothers, of someone who has never done a single good act but claims that he has faith. Will that faith save him? If one of the brothers or one of the sisters is in need of clothes and has not enough food to live on, and one of you says to them, 'I wish you well; keep yourself warm and eat plenty,' without giving them these bare necessities of life, then what good is that? Faith is like that: if good works do not go with it, it is quite dead. This is the way to talk to people of that kind: 'You say you have faith and I have good deeds; I will prove to you that I have faith by showing you my good deeds – now you prove to me that you have faith without any good deeds to show.' The Word of the Lord.

GOSPEL ACCLAMATION Galatians 6:14

Alleluia, alleluia! My only glory is the cross of our Lord Jesus Christ, which crucifies the world to me and me to the world. Alleluia!

GOSPEL Mark 8:27-35

A reading from the holy Gospel according to Mark

Jesus and his disciples left for the villages round Caesarea Philippi. On the way he put this question to his disciples, 'Who do people say I am?' And they told him. 'John the Baptist,' they said, 'others Elijah; others again, one of the prophets.' 'But you,' he asked, 'who do you say I am?' Peter spoke up and said to him, 'You are the Christ.' And he gave them strict orders not to tell anyone about him. And he began to teach them that the Son of Man was destined to suffer grievously, to be rejected by the elders and the chief priests and the scribes, and to be put to death, and after three days to rise again; and he said all this quite openly. Then, taking him aside, Peter started to remonstrate with him. But, turning and seeing his disciples, he rebuked Peter and said to him, 'Get behind me, Satan! Because the way you think is not God's way but man's. 'He called the people and his disciples to him and said, 'If anyone wants to be a follower of mine, let him renounce himself and take up his cross and follow me. For anyone who wants to save his life will lose it; but anyone who loses his life for my sake, and for the sake of the gospel, will save it.' **The Gospel of the Lord.**

The chalice of blessing that we bless is a communion in the Blood of Christ; and the bread that we break is a sharing in the Body of the Lord.
