You ask and do not receive, because you ask wrongly. We ask wrongly of life, of the world and of God, because we ask selfishly. We ask for our own well-being, our own pleasure and comfort, our own self-interest. Listening to and contemplating the Word is a good antidote to this.

Regarding the Gospel along the way they had argued about who was the most important. With affection and affection, with care and love, the Lord Jesus again shows us his pedagogy by reminding us, trying to get us back through the heart, that it is not power, fame, glory, money, success, that fills the heart of the human being.

He gives them an idea and shows them a gesture. Idea: it is only by serving others that the heart of man is fulfilled. Gesture: to place a child, the smallest and most vulnerable, those who do not count, those who no one takes into account, and to put him as a model of how people should be: simple, sincere, spontaneous, vulnerable. He who welcomes me does not welcome me, but the one who sent me. There is a question that, perhaps more than ever, our world today is asking itself, even if it does not verbalise it at all: Why should we trust what Jesus says?

Why, if everything cries out with the opposite message - that happiness and fulfilment come from power, from having, from fame and success, and that littleness, service, weakness are a source of discomfort - should we accept what Jesus teaches?
